What is astrology?

This is a question which has been asked by astrologers, and friends and critics of astrology, for the last two thousand years. It's a question which continues to engage us in the twenty-first century. *The Sophia Centre at the University of Wales Trinity Saint David* exists to study this question. Now, for the first time since 2009, the Sophia Centre is returning to Amsterdam for three days of talks, debate and discussion, hosted by the *Academie voor Toegepaste Astrologie*.

Dr. Nick Campion, Dr. Bernadette Brady and Dr. Darrelyn Gunzburg will be leading three days of teaching based on the University of Wales' MA in Cultural Astronomy and Astrology. Some of the MA's Dutch graduates will also be giving short presentations based on their studies.



The MA, now in its thirteenth year, is the only academic course of its kind in the world. It is taught on-line using the internet and webinars so there is no need to travel to Wales. We form an international community of students and scholars spanning all five continents, from South Africa to Scotland, China to Argentina, and Russia to the USA. We study the history and culture of astrology in all parts of the world and in all times, from the ancient world to the present day.
